



PRIVACY POLICY

As set out in Article 13 of Legislative Decree no. 196/03, the “Data Protection Act”, Barex Italiana S.r.l, based in Via Amleto Grazia 11, Zola Predosa (BO), in accordance with its role as owner of data handling, is required to provide you with information related to the collection, handling and use of your personal data. In particular:

- This document is related solely to the website of the company Barex Italiana S.r.l. which is accessible by electronic means via the address: <http://www.barex.it> and does not regard other websites that may be accessible by the user via links contained on the website;

- Barex Italiana S.r.l does not possess and does not intend to acquire nor process your personal data legally defined as “sensitive” and/or “judicial” in compliance with Paragraphs d) and e) of Article 4 of Legislative Decree 196/03;

- Type of data handled

a) Personally provided information

The user is free to submit personal data to the Owner of data handling. The optional, explicit and voluntary sending of emails to the email address indicated on the site and the compilation of the electronic “information” forms (available for download from the site) to enquire about our services or in response to promotions, advertising material, cost estimates and any supply of goods and/or services, require us to hold the sender’s email address as well as any other personal data included in the message and/or electronic forms;

b) Browsing data

Information systems and software procedures necessary for the correct operation of this website routinely record certain personal data required by internet communication protocols (i.c.d. traffic data). This information is not collected to be associated with an identified individual however could, by its nature and through processing and association with information held by third parties, enable users to be identified.

This category of information includes: IP addresses or domain names of the computers that connect to the site, URIs (Uniform Resource Identifier) of the requested resources, the date and time of the enquiry and other parameters concerning the user’s operating system and other general computer information.

An IP address is a number automatically assigned to your computer each time you connect to internet through your Internet Provider or through a company network that uses the same internet protocols. IP addresses are used by websites to enable them to send their pages.

Barex S.r.l. cannot associate this address to an individual since it is often assigned dynamically to the user by your Internet Provider or blocked by a company firewall. The address changes each time you connect to the internet and only your Provider or company can trace the user that has been given this address during previous connection sessions.

IP addresses are therefore anonymous to us, since they cannot be easily associated to an identified user and traffic data is used solely to obtain anonymous statistical information on site usage and to check it is operating properly. It may be used to ascertain responsibility in case of potential computer crimes against the site.

c) Cookies

You can browse our site <http://www.barex.it> anonymously and access certain information without revealing your identity.

We use cookies to improve our site to best serve you and to record page access on the site. A cookie is a small data file placed on your browser by a web server and can only be read by the same server. It is not an executable code and does not transmit viruses.



Nearly all browsers are programmed to accept cookies. You can configure the browser to warn you when you receive a cookie and to offer you the choice of accepting it or not (certain web pages require cookie authorization and users who select not to receive them will not be able to access those pages);

- Personal information linked to the web services offered by this site (hosted at D-sign S.r.l. Via Scandellara 58/2 - 40138, Bologna, Italy) is processed at the central offices of the Owner of the data handling manually (e.g. on paper) and/or electronically and/or by telecommunications. Specific safety measures are adopted to prevent loss of data, illicit or incorrect use and unauthorized access;
- Personal data will only be used to:
 - 1) Perform the service or action you requested;
 - 2) Send marketing communications via email or fax including promotional and advertising material, commercial information and offers regarding services provided by our company.
- Should you choose not to leave your personal data or you leave partial or inaccurate data for the purposes described in point 1) above, it may make it impossible for us to satisfy your request in cases where your request calls for this data. Personal data handling in this case does not require your explicit consensus. Providing personal data for the purposes described in point 2) above is at your discretion and as such, choosing not to leave your personal data will only mean that Barex Srl will not be able to improve our services to best serve you. Processing of your personal data in this case requires your consensus;
- The personal data you provide will only be passed on to third parties if it is necessary to do so. notwithstanding communications made when we are compelled to do so by EC law, regulations or normatives, the data collected may be communicated to parties or categories of parties such as: public authorities or institutions, IT or company consulting firms, external professionals and/or companies that supply services and consulting (e.g. accounting, fiscal, legal etc.); other suppliers of goods and/or services required to satisfy your needs; all parties that are enabled by law or secondary normatives to access the data.
- The category of parties that, in their role as data handlers, may gain knowledge of your personal data because of their respective role and according to instructions received, are internal personnel and/or our collaborators who have been specifically authorized to handle such data in order to perform the above mentioned tasks or for IT system management operations;
- The propagation of your personal data is not foreseen.
- Your personal data may be divulged to investigate, prevent or take legal action against illicit activities, suspected fraud and situations that may cause physical harm, violate the terms and conditions present on our website or in any other case that we are required to do so by the authorities;
- Your rights:
 - a) As set out in Article 13 of Legislative decree no. 196/03, you have the right, at any time, to receive confirmation whether this data exists or not and to know its content and origin, to verify its accuracy, request its integration or updating, or correct inaccuracies;
 - b) As set out in the same article, you have the right to request the cancellation, the transformation to anonymous data or the blocking of handled data which violates the law as well as the right to oppose, at any time, for legitimate reasons the handling of the data;
